LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds : A ball is out of bounds if it lies :

- Inside the barbed wire and outside the perimeter boundary in various parts of the Course.
- The area beyond the fence left of 1st fairway near practice putting green and extending to the boundary wall marked with white lines/stakes & the tennis court adjacent to the 4th Tee.
- The machinery sheds and its extension marked with white line/stakes left of the 10th fairway.
- The tea lawn, i.e. the area enclosed by the low wall on the left of the 18th green.
- The maintenance shed area and its extension marked with white line/stakes on the left of the 9th fairway.

Water Hazards: Defined by yellow posts/lines.

Lateral Water Hazards: Defined by red posts/lines.

Obstruction

- a) Any seat, screen, tree guard, tube well, pump, hydrant, concrete structure, shamiana, marker, post, angle iron pillar, culvert, bridge or building is an immovable obstruction and Rule 24(2) applies.
- b) All paved roads or paths with red surkhi are obstructions and Rule 24(2) applies.

Integral part of the Course

- c) All tracks and paths within the perimeter of the course (other than described above under point "B" of obstruction) are an integral part of the course and are not obstructions. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).
